Materials List:

- **Basic set of Acrylic Paints** (primary colors and white), additional colors as you prefer. Will be discussed in class.
- One **canvas**, and multiple (3 or 4) **canvas boards** 9x12" or larger
- **Mixing tray** for paints: large enamel 'butchers' tray' is recommended (available at Jerry's Artarama in Elmwood section of West Hartford).
- **Parchment paper** on roll or palette paper
- **Brushes:** Long handled acrylic or oil nylon or bristle brushes in a set of various shapes. Student grade brushes are fine.
- **Retarder** or Slow-Dri medium
- **Acrylic medium** (gloss or matte)
- **Paper Towels**
- **Water Container** (old large yogurt container or large glass jar is fine)
- **Soft pencil**
- **Color wheel**

1. Sap Green
2. Cobalt Violet
3. Permanent Rose
4. Ultramarine Blue
5. Cadmium Red
6. Cadmium Yellow Medium
7. Naples Yellow
8. Burnt Sienna
9. Unbleached Titanium
10. Burnt Umber

Cool Colors

1. Pthalo Green or Viridian
2. Payne's Grey
3. Cerulean Blue or Cobalt Blue
4. Prussian Blue
5. Alizarin Crimson
6. Lemon Yellow
7. Raw Umber
8. Raw Sienna

Titanium White

I make my Black = Alizarin Crimson, Prussian Blue and a drop of Cad Yellow.
